### Hints On Using Bridgemates

#### Reviewing scores entered

Think you might have entered the wrong score on a board or perhaps you are not sure you have entered the result at all? You may not actually need to call the director. Wake up the Bridgemate by pressing "OK". Then have a look at the bottom right of the screen. If you see the word "SCORES", then pressing the button on the right just below the screen (the same button that is used to "ACCEPT" a score) will bring up a list of all the scores that have been entered for that round.

Press the button below this caption to list the scores.

The scores are shown in board number order. Pressing the button below the “BACK” label will exit this screen. If you do need to fix a score, press the button below the “CORREC” label.

Press the button below this caption to exit this screen.

Press the button below this caption to delete a score.

After you press the “CORREC” button, you will be asked to enter a board number. Type in the board number followed by OK. This will erase the result and the correct result can then be entered in the normal manner.

Just another hint; if you end up on an unexpected screen when entering a score, check for the “BACK” option in the lower left-hand corner. You may have missed pressing “OK” after the number of tricks.
