Director's Corner

These most common director calls I get and what you can do to help avoid them.

Revoke	As Declarer or Defender, you may ask any other player, "Having none?". Dummy may only ask Declarer.
Lead Out of Turn	Lead Face Down. Not only is this the law, it allows for correction without penalty.
Insufficient Bid	This is a matter of paying attention before you bid. If you have trouble reading your opponent's bid, ask before you bid.
